One in 2,000 people are born with sex chromosomes, external genitalia, or an internal reproductive system that is not considered "standard" for either male or female. Surgical "correction" has been the standard of medical care for over 50 years, but the protocol has come under intense scrutiny as many adult survivors voice their outrage of what was done to them as children. In hospitals across the United States, 5 children each day subjected to nonconsensual cosmetic genital surgeries. CCMC is representative of every hospital that facilitates genital mutilation of infants and children whose lives will forever be physically and emotionally scarred with shame, secrecy and isolation.
